


### Land Acknowledgement

### Equity Bursaries


#### NS Forest Innovation Trust Award

- 2021-22: 13 full-tuition bursaries
- 2022-23: 16 full-tuition bursaries

#### Eligibility

Equity-deserving groups including Indigenous, African Nova Scotian and women learners.

To encourage people to enter forestry -related fields that will contribute to innovation and growth in the forestry sector in Nova Scotia.

### Applied Research & Innovation

#### Innovation Voucher Program

- Grants of up to \$25,000 for innovative ecological forestry projects
- 3 streams: bioenergy, entrepreneurship, woodlot management

#### Family Forest Network

- 200 site pilot for implementing ecological forestry on private land
- De-risking and providing incentives for landowners

#### **Future Research Forest**

- 500 acres located near Truro Campus
- Potential research station

Leadership & Student Workforce

- NSCC on Steering Committee, and sub-committees
- Student Workforce Solutions for FFN partners
  - 2023 Pilot
    - 8-10 students
    - 7 different FFN employers
    - Across all regions; variety of different Jobs
    - Range from 5 to 15 weeks
    - \$15 hourly grant to employers for work term
  - 2024 Expansion to 1620 funded positions



### Family Forest Network Plug-In

Training Plan & Data Management Services

- NSCC can further support the Training Plan for FFN partners, contractors and others:
  - Multiple Campus Locations
  - Supporting Webinar and other series
  - Adding Credentials to Courses for further growth
- NSCC will soon add new Forest Data Analyst resources
  - New Research Associate position for FFN
    - Maps and Pre- and Post-site Data
  - Technology to support this work



### Family Forest Network Plug-In

Intentional and Ongoing Collaboration

- NSCC and FFN are entering into a lease for space!!
  - Centre of Forest Innovation was designed with collaboration in mind
  - NSCC has a convener role within sector
  - New office space being set up for FFN in Centre alongside our faculty, and other professional staff.
    - Co-locates innovation, teaching and learning.
